LUNGS advocates on behalf of membership diversity, permanent community gardens, and public green spaces.

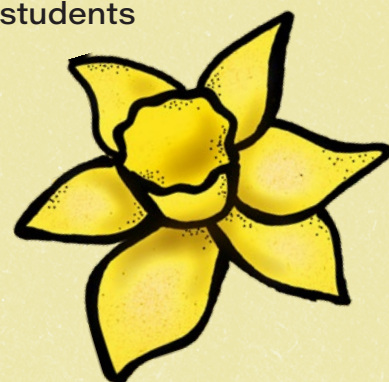
All the LUNGS community gardens are operated by volunteers, who accept their role as stewards of the earth and strive to contribute to the health and well-being of our neighborhood. The gardens each have their own unique personality; each is managed under their own governing rules. LUNGS SYEP

In 2014 LUNGS began working with New York City's Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) and the Chinese-American Planning Council (CPC) to organize and supervise NYC students in paid jobs as they work for six weeks in LUNGS community gardens. SYEP provides numerous health benefits for the students as well as giving them a hands-on immersive study in the science of sustainability. Students learn self-reliance and gain critical employment experience while working with other students and the volunteer gardeners. Our community benefits by getting needed intensive projects completed in the gardens and promoting the cross-pollination of gardeners' know-how with the energy of youth.

LUNGS ARTS FESTIVALS

LUNGS has two annual community-wide celebrations. The gardening season kick-offs with **LUNGS Spring Awakening** which begins with a parade through the neighborhood highlighting LUNGS community gardens, and ending on Ave B, which is closed to traffic. Festivities continue in conjunction with NYC's Open Streets program. Free pony rides, music, performances and more are presented throughout the afternoon. In addition several gardens offer arts performances well.

This fall look for the **15th Annual LUNGS Harvest Arts Festival**. This ten day arts and cultural festival is free to the public and staged in more than 30 community gardens. The festival is fun, educational, and imaginative. Each garden designs its own art program and level of participation. Painting, photography, sculpture, workshops, spoken-word, performance, art installations, poetry, music, dance, and films have been featured. The programs are as varied and multi-dimensional as the gardens.

ADDITIONAL LUNGS PROGRAMS

LUNGS 5th Annual Theater Festival will take place on June 6-7 on the beautiful outdoor stage in 6B Garden, corner of Avenue B & 6th Street. This is a locally curated festival of five one-act 30 minute plays, 2-5pm. Ridiculous, dramatic, and magical surrealism. LUNGS CSA

Since 2013, LUNGS has operated a CSA (Community Sourced Agriculture) each summer. The season runs from June/July until Thanksgiving. Fresh produce is delivered, sorted, and distributed every Friday, 5-7pm at DeColores Yard, 311 E. 8th St (Aves B & C). LUNGS purchases the produce wholesale from GROWNYC. Participation is open to anyone: Purchase a bag of fresh veggies for just \$15/week by paying one week in advance in person, or sign up (or get more details) by sending your name, email, and phone number to CSA@lungnyc.org and pay in advance via PayPal.

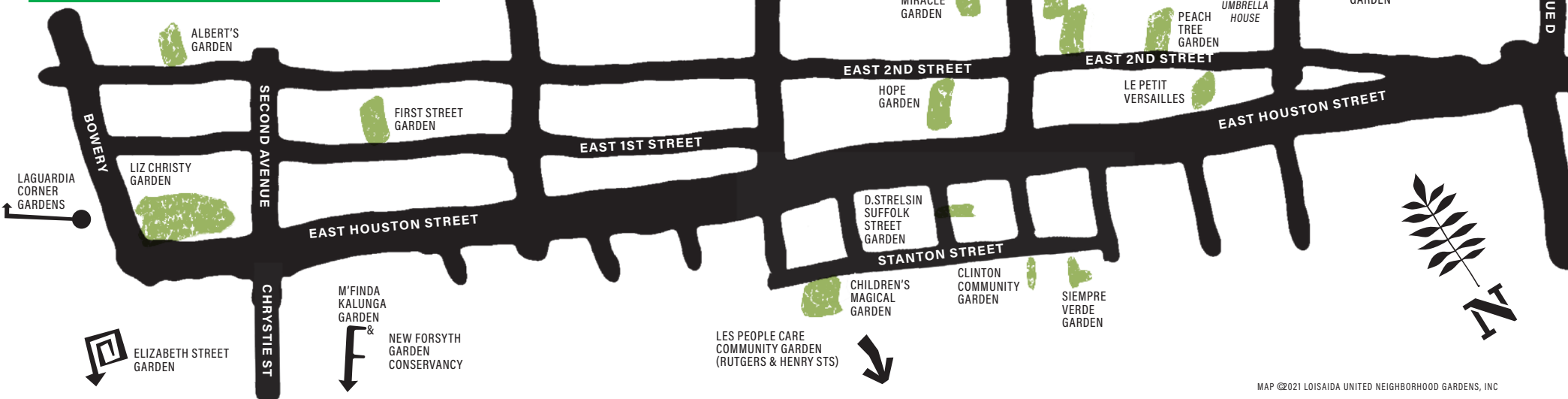
